SOME OF THE BASIC QUESTIONS...

• **How do I register to vote?** Village residents register at Village Hall. Pepin Township residents contact the Township Clerk (Jill Auth: 442-6210) for a voter registration form & polling place. Pre-registration is encouraged! – driver’s license or valid ID required!

• **Where do I renew my drivers’ license?** The License Examiner is located at 104 E. Main Street, Durand. (Limited hrs: 8:15-4:45 - 3rd Wed). For locations & hrs of all regional DMV Service Center, see www.dot.wisconsin.gov.

• **How do I title & register my vehicle in WI?** New state residents must display WI plates on their vehicle ASAP. Present your current vehicle title at Village Clerk’s office, complete form MV1, and pay title & plate fees. You will be issued a temporary plate, and your new WI plate and title will arrive in the mail.

• **Are there local food pantries?** Pepin County Food Pantry location: 306-A West Main Street, Durand (672-3203). Local food pantry at Immanuel Lutheran Church, Pepin. Call Mary Seymour (442-2615) for hours of drop off and distribution.

• **How do I dispose of recyclables and non-recyclables?**
▪ The solid waste site accepts these recyclables at no charge: newspaper, magazines, household paper, junk mail, cardboard, glass bottles & jars, plastic containers, metal containers, scrap metal. ▪ Small non-recyclable materials may be taken to the collection site in special county solid waste bags, available for purchase at the grocery store, convenience store, and hardware store. ▪ Grass clippings, leaves, flowers, vegetable garden materials can be composted in your yard or placed in the compost pile at the collection site. Brush and woody yard waste can be placed in the brush pile. ▪ Certain large, bulky items & appliances are accepted for a fee. Call 672-5709 for more information.
